

Princess Diana Vintage Crochet Shawl Pattern

For a shawl that embodies so much grace and beauty, you will want to work up the Princess Diana Vintage Crochet Shawl Pattern. Whether you make it as a fashion statement for a night out or as a prayer shawl for a strong woman you're thinking about, this shawl is a gorgeous find.

Made up of classic shell stitches as well as v stitches, this is one of the prettiest crochet wraps and shawls patterns you'll ever find. Plus, you will be warm and feel wonderful in this shawl. The rose blush colored yarn will look good with any complexion and adds to the coziness of the crochet pattern.

It has the air of pure regality that will make anyone feel royal while wearing this lovely shawl.



Crochet Gauge: 4 rows = 2"; Shell in sc = 2"

Finished Size: 18 inches x 63 inches

Materials Needed:

Crochet Hook: I/9 or 5.5 mm hook

Yarn Weight: (4) Medium Weight/Worsted Weight and Aran (16-20 stitches to 4 inches)

Red Heart Soft: 4 skeins 9770 Rose Blush

Abbreviations Used:

Shell: (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in space or stitch as indicated in instructions.

V Stitch (V st): (dc, ch 1, dc) in space or stitch as indicated in instructions.

Note: Shawl is worked in two halves. The first half begins at the center of the shawl and is worked to one end. The second half begins across the opposite side of the foundation chain and is worked to the other end.

First Half Crochet Shawl Pattern:

(beginning at center of shawl)

Row 1 (RS): Ch 74, sc in 2nd ch from hook, [skip 3 chs, Shell in next ch, skip 3 chs, sc in next ch] across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in same stitch, [ch 1, V St in ch space of next Shell, ch 1, V St in next sc] across ending with ch 1, 2 dc in last stitch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first stitch, [Shell in ch space of V St, sc in ch space of next V St] across,

ending with Shell in last V St, 2 dc in last stitch, turn.

Rows 4 – 51: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

Row 52 (WS): (Sc, ch 3, sc) in first sc, *ch 3, sc in ch 1 space of Shell, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, repeat from * across ending (sc, ch 3, sc) in last sc and fasten off.

Second Half Crochet Shawl Pattern:

Row 1 (RS): With right side facing and working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in first sc, [Shell in ch below Shell, sc in next sc] across ending sc in last sc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in same stitch, [ch 1, V St in ch space of next Shell, ch 1, V St in next sc] across ending with ch 1, 2 dc in last stitch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first stitch, [Shell in ch space of V St, sc in ch space of next V St] across,

ending with Shell in last V St, 2 dc in last stitch, turn.

Rows 4 – 51: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

Row 52 (WS): (Sc, ch 3, sc) in first sc, *ch 3, sc in ch 1 space of Shell, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, repeat from * across ending (sc, ch 3, sc) in last sc and fasten off.
